Safe as Houses: Home Security

This project provides home security measures and is available to anyone living in South Lanarkshire over the age of 60 or of any age and living with a disability who has experienced doorstep crime, house breaking or feels vunerable.

Also available to clients of any age who have experienced domestic abuse.

Following a referral, we will carry out a Home Security Survey and offer advice on this.

We may be able to provide other home secuity devices to keep clients safe:

- Personal audible alarms
- Window and door impact devices
- Door viewers

This service is free of charge and all equipment supplied is free.

Clients can self-refer or refer via a partner agency such as Victim Support, Women's Aid, ASSIST or any other support agency you are working with.

Safe as Houses: Home Safety

This project provides home safety measures and is available for anyone over the age of 60 or of any age living with a disability and resident in South Lanarkshire

Clients can self-refer to this project and arrange for a Home Safety Survey to be carried out. We will discuss the results of the survey with you and work with you to remove the hazards identified. We will be able to do this by making minor changes to your home or by installing some safety equipment.

We can install some safety equipment free of charge or install equipment provided by you.

Examples of equipment installed:

- Solar lights
- Grab rails
- Multi plugs
- Timer switches
- Non slip bath mats
- Other equipment identified



Safe as Houses : Under 5's

This project is targeted at children under the age of 5 living in South Lanarkshire.

Following a referral from a partner agency or a self-referral we will visit your home and carry out a Home Safety Survey. We will discuss the survey with you and offer safety advice. We will install safety equipment requested by the referrer or identified in the survey free of charge.

Equipment we may install:

- Stair gates
- Night lights
- Corner protection
- Window restrictors
- Furniture anchors
- Other equipment identified

Our aim is to keep children safe at home and hope to achieve this by identifying and eliminating hazards found during the Home Safety survey.
